COVID SAFE PLAN SUNDAY SERVICES

If you are not feeling well, please take a rest at home and DO NOT attend the service. If you are experiencing respiratory symptoms, please be tested for COVID-19.

We are carefully monitoring the continually evolving COVID situation in Queensland and services will go ahead only if we remain confident that it is safe for people to attend.

Protecting the health of all in attendance is of paramount importance. It is good to see that attendees are adjusting to the different practices. Please take note of the changed arrangements. If in doubt, check with an usher. We will continue to be conservative in our arrangements and will carefully monitor COVID developments and recommendations. It is better to be safe than sorry.

The service will have numbers limited to allow for the $2m^2$ rule (previously $4m^2$). We can accommodate up to 50 people in the church. Attendees must sit at least 1.5m apart, though family/ household groups can sit together.

All attendees will be required to provide name and contact details via the Check In Qld app. Your contact details will be managed by the government. You should arrive 5 mins early to allow time to complete these formalities. We ask that you allow us to check your temperature on arrival. Alternatively, if you do not have a smart phone we can enter your details for you.

Announcements about procedural matters will be made before and after the service, as appropriate.

□ We will not be using hymn books for the service order; rather you will be given a single-use booklet.

There will be coloured markers to indicate where to sit in pews. Please sit with a marker at your back. Please avoid moving around the church or changing your seat during the service.

Ushers will assist you with seating, guide you when communion is distributed and help with the flow of people as we leave the church building.

There will be no collection, but you are invited to make a retiring offering as you leave the church. You are encouraged to use electronic giving facilities to provide financial support to St Andrew's.

The toy box has been removed so if you have children who normally might use the toy box, please bring your own toys.

□ Morning tea will be served after the service. Refreshments will be brought to you. Please do not serve yourself.

Please: No shaking hands or hugging friends that you may not have seen for a while. Practise social distancing at all times.

We will take your temperature when you enter the church. If you have a temperature above

37.4 we may ask you to wear a mask while you are in the church and/or sit at the rear of the church.

We remain vigilant.
