

COVID SAFE PLAN SUNDAY SERVICES (Current at 19 November 2021)

If you are not feeling well, please take a rest at home and DO NOT attend the service. If you are experiencing respiratory symptoms, please see your doctor and be tested for COVID-19.

We are carefully monitoring the continually evolving COVID situation in Queensland and updating our protocols accordingly.

Protecting the health of all in attendance is of paramount importance. It is good to see that attendees have adjusted to the modified practices. Please take note of any changed arrangements published here, highlighted in the weekly newsletter and announced at the beginning of the service. If in doubt, check with an usher. We will continue to be conservative in our arrangements and will carefully monitor COVID developments and recommendations.

- Vaccinated and unvaccinated people are allowed to attend services, but numbers remain limited to allow for 1 person per 2m². We can accommodate up to 80 people in the church. Attendees must sit at least 1.5m apart, though family/ household groups can sit together. Masks may be worn if preferred but are not required where social distancing is maintained.
- All attendees are required to provide name and contact details via the Check In Qld app. Your contact details will be managed by the government. You should arrive 5 mins early to allow time to complete these formalities. Alternatively, if you do not have a smart phone we can enter your details for you.
- Announcements about procedural matters are made before and after the service, as appropriate. Instructions about the modified communion procedures will be announced.
- We do not use hymn books for the service order; rather you will be given a single-use booklet. The paper is re-cycled.
- There are coloured markers to indicate where to sit in pews. Please sit with a marker at your back. Please avoid moving around the church or changing your seat during the service.
- Ushers will assist you with seating, guide you when communion is distributed and help with the flow of people as we leave the church building.
- You may light candles in the prayer bowl – please follow the directions posted on the wall.
- There is no collection, but you are invited to make a retiring offering as you leave the church. You are encouraged to use electronic giving facilities to provide financial support to St Andrew's.
- The toy box has been removed so if you have children who normally might use the toy box, please bring your own toys.
- Morning tea is served after the service. Refreshments will be brought to you. Please do not serve yourself.
- Please: No shaking hands or hugging friends that you may not have seen for a while. Practise social distancing at all times.
- We will take your temperature when you enter the church. If you have a temperature above 37.4 we may ask you to wear a mask while you are in the church and/or sit at the rear of the church.
